### Enrichment 2012 (9 – 13 July) – Year 12

During the College Enrichment programme, launched with the students in a Gathering in the last week of term 1, Year 12 students have a number of opportunities.

**Programme 1:** They can take part in one of the overseas visits to Germany or Spain.

**Programme 2:** They may be completing their Silver Duke of Edinburgh expedition or involved within the Youth Theatre during the week.

*Details of these activities are detailed in separate letters which students have had the opportunity to pick up from the College reception or from the Tutors who are running these activities.*

**Programme 3:** For all other students in Year 12 the week gives them the opportunity to be involved in one of or more of the activities shown on the table overleaf. *These activities enable Year 12 students to work alongside the tutorial staff, supporting younger students. In previous years our Year 12 students have found this experience enjoyable and very worthwhile. Many have used this opportunity to enhance their CV or their 'personal statement' for their university application.*

*It is expected that students will make a commitment to at least one activity but they may take part in more than one activity if they wish. They must not commit to activities taking place at the same time and it is hoped that their chosen activity will match their specialist subject areas or their interests. Students will be expected to commit to 3 days and any remaining time that they have will allow them to work on A Level/BTEC study and space will be allocated in College for this during the week. However, students may work from home.*

*Year 12 students will complete an application for their preferred activity during Tutor Time early next term. For some activities there will be an additional cost; where appropriate this will be a contribution towards entrance fees, travel and/or accommodation.*

If there are any concerns relating to the cost of any programme, please contact Miss Lauren Walendziewski in due course, and in confidence. Individual arrangements can be made to pay for the cost of the programme in weekly/monthly instalments.
